Since Helping Hands Ministries of Harrisburg is downsizing—serving one day a week—we have some cooking equipment for sale. The cost of electricity and the cost of propane have gone way up, donations down, and since we are serving one night a week we don't need so many freezers, or fridges. I have 2 freezers both Frigidaire and a large French door, freezer on the bottom Whirlpool refrigerator. I also have stainless large pans and 6 inch square smaller pans, also serving utensils, spoons slotted and not.

2020 was a tough year many people from restaurants to ministries to us personally. We increased our serving days to five nights a week serving outside for over a year. Restaurants changed their menu and started making less food which meant less food donated. Our costs went up and donations went down and it took a toll on me physically. I had quite a few surgeries that year and in 2021 as well as covid, hence taking a sabbatical so I could let me body heal. Fast forward to Thanksgiving 2021 we served a Thanksgiving meal outside and then Christmas and New Years as well. The first week n January we started preparing meals and putting them in to go containers and taking them downtown to the hungry. After doing that for months, St. Michaels opened their doors (again) to us coming in to serve on night a week. We are so blessed.

Meet B. I have known him for many, many years he used to hang out with couple ladies (who have died) as drinking buddies. As we know alcohol can take its toll on the body. B has been fighting liver cancer and is may go to Philly to the cancer center; he knows it's a one way trip; he will go there to die. He's not sure he wants to go; he would be far from friends and family and die alone. We have had the discussion about the Lord and salvation. Bill has accepted the Lord.
